

Ecosystem processes and services


Environmental Flow Regime

"...schedule of flow...that reflects seasonal and yearly fluctuations that...vary geographically, by specific location...,...support a sound ecological environment."

"... without regard to the need for the water for other uses,...."

Flow Regime: Description not Prescription

Not –creating a new ecosystem

Flow standards ≠ flow regime

Not -values that should never be changed

Successes and Lessons

Successes

- Flow standards: 11 basins
- Adaptive management: \$6 million since 2013

Lessons

- "Whiskey is for drinking, water is for fighting"
- No play, no pay
- 1-year deadline work done quickly
- Ecological data related to flow very limited
